Tuesday, April 28 	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Uke lesson and assessment intro live at 2pm! Come, one and all! Playing and overview of songwriting project2. Set a 1 on 1 appointment with Jim for uke check-in and lesson.

Friday, May 1 	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Songwriting analysis: ballads. Post in collaboration space2. Make a flipgrid video of you playing one song you've learned. This is a formative assessment to help you progress!
