

## Financial Math Home Learning Plan for Week of March 30th

### Goals:

- 1) Spend some time finishing **My Transportation Plan**. Please reach out if you have questions. Most of you seem to have more work to do on this. **Do this Monday**
- 2) Complete the **Intro to Investments Activity**, by watching the video and signing up for a live Financial Math class. Class will be held on Tuesday Morning at 11am, 2pm, and 4pm. I'll figure out a way for you to reserve a slot once I talk to JohnBo and he teaches me how. **Do this Tuesday**
- 3) Revise your Financial Campfire (as I return it to you). Sorry for the delay with these.
- 4) By the end of the week, I hope that each of you will be ready for me to send you the Mathematical Problem Solving Assessment: **If I Had a Million Dollars, Would I Be Rich?** This is a cool, standalone assessment that challenges you to find a manageable and consistent way to save one million dollars. You need to be caught up to date with the class before I give it to you, but I want you to take that in the nicest possible way. The spreadsheets that we have built to date are needed to be able to solve this challenge. I want to help you understanding the technology with the technology work we have already done. So to qualify for this new assessment you need the following completed.
  - a. How Banks Work
  - b. Financial Campfire
  - c. My Transportation Plan

When you have completed the three requirements noted above, I will send you the assessment (earliest on Thursday), and you will have one week to complete it.
